Economic Development

Supporting the creation of the Maine Economic Development Strategy 2020-2029



Investment

Advocating for increased funding for post-secondary education and training, including free community college and the Maine State Grant Program



Early Childhood Education

Championing investments & policies that benefit families, children, educators, & employers - including public Pre-K expansion



Navigator Network

Developing a robust navigator network to support adult learners across Maine



Experiential Learning

Supporting education and workforce training initiatives including apprenticeships, dual enrollment, ELOs, CTE, industry partnerships & adult education
