Children and Family Services

Our staff are dedicated individuals with experience working with children and families in a variety of settings. This experience gives them the knowledge of a vast array of resources available in your community to assist your child and family.

How does my child qualify?

- ✓ MaineCare eligible
- ✓ Documented mental health diagnosis or developmental disability
- ✓ Have a need for resources to support your child and family with learning more about and dealing with symptoms and behaviors, from diagnosis/disability

How will Catholic Charities staff help my child and family?

- ✓ We meet you at your home or in the community, whichever is most convenient for you
- ✓ Assistance connecting to resources such as in-home supports, counseling or medication management
- ✓ Support in school IEP meetings to assure your child's needs are being met
- ✓ Referrals for specialized evaluations
- ✓ Provide general knowledge about community resources for a variety of needs such as housing, food, and financial

What services are available?

Behavioral Health Home services provide a unique opportunity for your family to benefit from the support/coordination efforts of a team of professionals. Through your Health Home Coordinator you will have access to a nurse care manager, family/youth support specialist, and clinical team leader. The BHH team also has access to a child and adolescent psychiatrist for consultation.

Who do I call for more information?

Call for more information or to make a self-referral. After a referral is completed, it will be assigned to staff as appropriate. Our referral process is a simple phone call that takes 5-10 minutes. Our goal is to have intake completed within 1 week of referral!
