

Adult Services

Behavioral Health Home Services provide a multidisciplinary approach to caring for adults with mental illness, balancing both physical and emotional health needs. The care team includes a nurse care manager, peer support, clinical team leader, and psychiatric and medical consultants, in addition to the Health Home Coordinator.

Community Integration provides traditional case management services to eligible adults with a mental illness.

Counseling Services provides individual, group, and intensive outpatient counseling for mental health, co-occurring, and substance use disorder treatment.

Also offered to clients receiving services:

- Comprehensive assessment
- Psychiatric evaluation
- Specialized counseling services for those re-entering the community from incarceration or on probation
- Trauma counseling for refugees
- Corrections case management and counseling

Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) and Medication Management Services (MMS) services are provided for individuals seeking medication supported treatment.

Opioid Health Home Services (OHH) provide a multidisciplinary, harm reduction approach to support individuals and families affected by opioid use. OHH's recovery process supports individuals in achieving optimal emotional and physical wellness through medication management, individual and group counseling support, nurse care management, peer support, and care coordination.

Representative Payee Services are provided through Catholic Charities Maine, as authorized by the Social Security Administration, to receive and manage Social Security or Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits on behalf of a beneficiary who is unable to manage their own finances. We work with clients to ensure their basic living needs are met, help with budgeting and establishing savings funds, and support clients' financial management in their best interests.

Residential Substance Use Disorder Treatment:

St. Francis Recovery Center is dedicated to bringing health, recovery and stability to the lives of men aged 18 and older. The Center provides individual and group clinical counseling in a drug- and alcohol-free residential environment staffed with 24-hour support coverage.

Freedom Place offers safe, supportive housing for up to 38 women while working on recovery from trauma, substance use, and other physical or emotional health challenges. Residents receive guidance, encouragement, and access to services that help them stay on the path to wellness. The program welcomes women from many walks of life — including those overcoming substance use, homelessness, domestic violence, previously incarcerated, or other difficult experiences — while creating a strong, recovery-focused community.

Parish Social Ministry

Parish Social Ministry (PSM) strengthens parish communities by providing social ministry program trainings and resources based on the individual needs of a parish.

Relief & Hope Service: Provides limited financial relief in seriously vulnerable situations and suggests more resources to explore.

Parish Grants: PSM administers the annual Matthew 25 Award, ongoing Matthew 25 Fund grants, and the diocesan Catholic Campaign for Human Development grants. As well, PSM assists parishes in identifying other funding sources.

Parish Training and Consultation: Tailored trainings on a variety of topics including aspects of Catholic Social Teaching; serving the poor, the sick and others in need; volunteer recruitment and management; facilitating assessments of community needs and parish responses.
