- 1. From 1 case on March 12th we now have more than 100 cases in Maine today.
- 2. The COVID-19 (Corona Virus) is a deadly disease and is spreading very fast in Maine. This disease is real!

- 4. Please keep yourself, your family and your community safe all the time. Don't allow anyone in your home except for the people who live there.

- **6.** Stay home as much as possible. Avoid taking your family members and friends grocery shopping. Children should avoid the playground.
- 7. Avoid gathering in groups of more than 10 people whether at home or in public. Social distancing doesn't mean visiting homes of friends/family & sitting less than 6 feet away from each other.
