## YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR A VETERAN'S EXEMPTION IF YOU ARE STILL SERVING

This form is to be used by any member of the armed forces who, on the 10/1 Assessment Date was in service in time of war and is still in service, and, by reason of continuous service, has not as yet received a separation from service or discharge certificate (DD-214). There are two options to apply:

- Until such time as the veteran appears personally and exhibits his or her discharge or copy, the service member should annually complete the form on the other side and have it signed by the commanding officer of the service member's unit, ship or station or by some other appropriate officer. The Affidavit should be forwarded to the Bolton Town Clerk by September 30<sup>th</sup>.
- 2. If the veteran or service member is currently serving in an active theater of war or hostilities, a parent, guardian, spouse or legal representative of such claimant can present a notarized statement stating that he or she is personally serving and is unable to appear in person by reason of such service, which statement shall be received by the Bolton Assessor by September 30<sup>th</sup>.
