- 2. Update on Business Map/CT Countryside Website
 - a. If you haven't, please upload your business information as well as any events that might occur to CT Countryside's website. This is free advertising, and our goal is to make this a one stop shop for the region.
 - b. Question that was raised: how are you promoting the website? How are making it accessible to the community?
 - c. Answer: Bolton has been sending email alerts to our businesses, as well as posting the information in Bolton Bulletin. It is up to the individual towns to promote within their respective communities. We have also launched social media accounts within the past month, this has generated some awareness.
- 3. AI Forum in Mansfield
 - a. Our next AI forum has been set for February 5th at UConn's Innovation Building. Same time as previously planned, with a tour and social right before the AI Forum. The goal is to help businesses learn tools such as video programs, how to create emails, and more by using AI. This event is open to both previous attendees and new attendees as well.
