
# Bolton Board of Education's Recommended Budget 2020 - 2021



The Bolton Public Schools empowers all students to embrace learning, build knowledge, develop skills, and become engaged global citizens.


#### We Believe:



#### Distribution of Increase




## **Projected Revenues**
