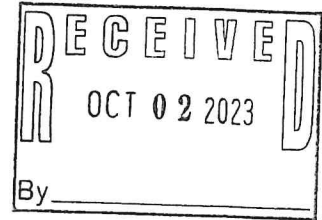
September Highlights

From the Town Administrator

- Received a STEAP grant award in the amount of \$500,000.00 for the Herrick Park field upgrades. This includes new playing field area, drainage improvements and additional parking.
- We received notification of our CEDAS (Connecticut Economic Development Association) Bronze level recertification for meeting best practice in land use and economic development.
- We received notice that we have achieved Bronze level recertification for Sustainable CT. This project took much work from many individuals and was truly a team effort.
- We met with the UCONN TAB (technical assistance for brownfields) program leader and a student who will aide us in understanding the possible reuse of the Notch Road site once the existing facility is removed.
- Our team is continuing to work on the next level plan for the Heritage farm Trail so we will be ready for another public informational meeting.
- Progress is continuing on the Connectivity Grant Trail and we hope to complete it very soon but that is weather dependent.
- Our Highway team is working on getting ready for reclaiming and paving on Williams Road and a portion of French Road. Signage has gone up and it's been posted in the bulletin.
- We continue to work with CT Department of Public Health to finalize paperwork for the septic system installation.
- We have held several meetings regarding the living history weekend. The team is comprised of both staff and volunteers and they have done an extraordinary job in planning.
- We have finalized plans and paperwork with Willscot and have a planned delivery date of on or about October 16th for delivery and set up. Set up will take a couple of days and we have our outside contractors getting set up to install power, water, internet and septic with all due haste.
- We are working on updating the Local Emergency operations Plan.
- We are working on a complete update and overhaul of the employee handbook.
- We are creating a master calendar to help us keep on track with timelines and deadlines for required activities.
