## NOVUS Post-Pandemic Pricing Realignment

- Novus recently completed a yearlong assessment to reevaluate our processes with regards to Managed Support
- Novus treats its managed support services like an insurance policy whereby once contracted we ensure our clients are fully supported even if it requires going over budget.
- Unlike insurance, we do not seek to maintain large margins; only to cover costs with a small margin that is used to support clients in need.
- During the pandemic period, IT labor rates skyrocketed and outpaced inflation by 77%-209%. This was due to increased demand and complexity in remote/cloud client environments.
- As a mission focused organization, Novus sought to absorb and postpone this cost impact on clients until economic conditions stabilized.
- Novus understands the impact this will have on our clients and is working with clients to phase-in the cost correction over a three-year period.

  - **Lighting Efficiency Upgrades**
