As a resident of Bolton on Stonehedge Lane since 2011, and as an individual who regularly travels through Bolton Notch by car, bike, and on foot, I have experienced this area for 25 years. This does not include the 15+ years I lived in Vernon and traveled this portion of road on my way to Willimantic to see family and Mansfield to attend church and UCONN events. I am in strong favor of the Town of Bolton and CRCOG's proposed concept for the Rt 6/Rt 44/I-384 interchange at Bolton Notch. This plan offers meaningful improvements to traffic flow while also reintroducing essential pedestrian and bicycle access that has been absent since the 1960s. Addressing this long-standing issue will help create a safer environment for all who use the roadway.

I encourage you to take the next step by authorizing CRCOG to submit the proposal to the DOT for review. The public will have a chance to share input during the DOT's design phase.
