Museum Key is Ready to Use! Bentley's new online Museum Pass Registration System

Our new online museum pass reservation system has launched and is ready for use. The system works much the same as our previous system, Museum Tix. The link for Museum Key is posted on the library website, and at the bottom of this posting. This will allow patrons to sign out a museum pass from their mobile, tablet, laptop or desktop. Patrons may select their choice of museum to visit, the date they wish to visit and print their pass from home or at the library. Some museums will accept a screen shot of your reservation, but Bentley strongly encourages you to print your pass. Contact any staff member at Bentley if you have questions.

eGo The Palace Project Supporting Summer Reading

The Division of Library Development (DLD) purchases content that supports **Summer Reading Programs** with the aim to provide titles in eBook and eAudio format, and in Spanish when available. DLD also purchases multiple copies of titles, and many classics are available

without loan restrictions.

Copies of Nutmegs, All CT Reads, and many other titles from various summer reading lists have been added to the Palace Project collection.

During the month of June, DLD purchased a total of 337 items for eGO CT for both platforms including suggested titles from the **Summer With The Library** page. There are now over 50,000 items provided for free to public libraries.


