PROPERTY TAX BILLS

Tax bills needed to be paid by August 1, 2024, adjusted Real Estate tax bills(only) affected by the error have until August 31, 2024, to pay without interest. Interest accrues at 1.5% per month from the July 1, 2024, due date if paid late on all bills.

Delinquent tax bills will be going out soon and motor vehicles tax bills that have not been paid will be reported to the Department of Motor Vehicles.

As the town navigates the best way to refund/credit some taxpayers for the unanticipated increase in revenue due to the error in assessments; please be aware that any estimation that the taxpayer makes on their own that results in an outstanding amount due will make you liable for the interest on the balance of that account.

REVISED TAX BILLS

Real Estate tax bills that had the wrong assessment have been updated and revised tax bills have been mailed out. These new amounts are also available online with the tax bill lookup link above. **These affected tax bills (only) have an extension of time to pay which is August 31, 2024.** These tax bills will accrue interest as of September 1, 2024, at a rate of 1.5% per month (4.5% as of 9/1/24 which includes July-September). All other tax bills accrue interest as of August 1, 2024, at a rate of 1.5% per month (3% as of 8/2/24 which includes July-August).

JUSTICE OF THE PEACE APPLICATIONS NOW BEING ACCEPTED

Pursuant to Section 9-184c of the Connecticut General Statutes, unaffiliated voters or minor party members who are interested in becoming Justices of the Peace may apply to the Town Clerk to be included in a lottery to determine who will fill any regular or vacancy slots for this position. This will be the only list of names to fill possible unaffiliated or minor party justice slots for the next four years.

In order to qualify, a voter must NOT be registered with a major political party (Democrat or Republican), nor can he or she have been registered with a major political party three months prior to August 1, 2024.
