TAX COLLECTOR'S OFFICE

Tax Bills will be mailed out by the end of June AND will be viewable and payable online at that time. These bills will be due July 1, 2026, and must be paid by or postmarked by August 3, 2026, to avoid interest. Interest accrues at 1.5% from the due date July 1st for a total of 18% per year. Please be aware that if your payment is late the interest rate is 3% from August 4-31st. Minimum interest is \$2.00 per bill.

WHAT IF I DO NOT RECEIVE A TAX BILL? Not receiving a tax bill does not invalidate the tax and/or interest. If you do not receive a tax bill you can check the "tax look up and pay" link on the town's website boltonct.gov or call or email our office if you still do not find it.

MOTOR VEHICLE ACCOUNTS: Please make sure to check your cars registration to make sure it is still active, which could be the reason why you did not receive the tax bill. If there is a lapse in your registration, please call the Assessor's office. They can add it on to the tax rolls once your registration has been renewed to avoid multiple tax bills later. REAL ESTATE ACCOUNTS: If your mortgage lender escrows and pays your taxes the bill will go to them to disperse payment.

If you recently paid off your mortgage, switched mortgage companies and now pay your own taxes, and you did not receive your tax bill please call our office to get a copy of your tax bill.

If you receive a bill that your mortgage holder is supposed to pay, please call and forward the bill to the mortgage holder so they have time to process and send the payment.

Please check the town's website BOLTONCT.GOV under Department -Tax Collector for other information such as Tax Lookup and Pay, Payment Options, FAQ's and Enforcement.
