PROPERTY TAX BILLS

Tax Bills will be mailed out by the end of June AND will be viewable and payable at that time. These bills will be due July 1, 2024 and must be paid by or postmarked by August 1, 2024 to avoid interest. Interest accrues at 1.5% from the due date July 1st for a total of 18% per year. Please be aware that if late the interest rate is 3% from August 2-31st.Minimum interest is \$2.00 per bill.

WHAT IF I DO NOT RECEIVE A TAX BILL?

Not receiving a tax bill does not invalidate the tax and/or interest. If you do not receive a tax bill you can check online and print it out with the above link and/or call our office if you still do not find it.

MOTOR VEHICLE ACCOUNTS:

Please make sure to check your cars registration to make sure it is still active which could be the reason why you did not receive the tax bill. If there was a lapse in your registration, please call the Assessor's office. They can add it on to the tax rolls once your registration has been renewed to avoid multiple tax bills later.

REAL ESTATE ACCOUNTS:

If you recently paid off your mortgage, switched mortgage companies and now pay your own taxes, and you did not receive your tax bill please either use the link above to find your account or call our office to get a copy of your tax bill.

If you receive a bill that your mortgage holder is supposed to pay, please call and forward the bill to the mortgage holder so they have time to process and send the payment.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

DELINQUENT MOTOR VEHICLE BILLS HAVE BEEN REPORTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

PLEASE PAY YOUR TAX BILL AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO AVOID HAVING A REGISTRATION HELD UP.

It will be necessary to have all accounts paid to be able to register a vehicle. Please make sure you pay your taxes **at least** 2 weeks before you need to register your vehicle to make sure you have no compliance issues. You can check DMV's online services under compliance issues to ensure you are clear before you go to DMV. If you need clearance before the 2-week period of time, then you will need to make your payment with cash, money order, credit/debit card online or in the office.

Please make us aware you are requesting a release for DMV as it is not immediately taken off.

PLEASE BE ADVISED The Town of Bolton is under contract with TaxServ Capital services for the collection of some of the Town's delinquent taxes. If your account was sent to TaxServ, you MUST call them to discuss your account and arrange payment. If you call the Tax Collector/Assessor, we will direct you to Tax Serv for payment.

FROM THE ASSESSOR'S OFFICE

PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR VETERANS WITH A 100% SERVICE-CONNECTED PERMANENT AND TOTAL DISABILITY RATING

During the 2024 session of the Connecticut State Legislature, a new exemption program was established for veterans with a 100% service-connected permanent and total disability rating from the US Veterans Administration:

CGS 12-81(83): AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR VETERANS WHO HAVE A SERVICE-CONNECTED PERMANENT AND TOTAL DISABILITY RATING.

Resident veterans with a service-connected permanent and total disability rating of 100% from the VA will receive an automatic tax exemption on their residence, to include the dwelling, house lot and any non-commercial outbuildings in the curtilage area, that is, the area surrounding a dwelling-house that includes the grounds and outbuildings immediately surrounding it.*

If the veteran does not own his or her dwelling, the 100% exemption will apply to a motor vehicle. If the veteran owns more than one vehicle, the exemption will be applied to the vehicle with the highest assessed value.

The exemption will be effective if the dwelling or motor vehicle is in a spouse's name.

VETERANS WITH A 100% RATING WILL AUTOMATICALLY RECEIVE THE EXEMPTION. Veterans with a change in their percentage rating should bring the new rating letter to the Assessor's Office.

The exemption carries over to the surviving spouse so long as the spouse remains unmarried.

Veterans that have not been able to file their 100% rating letter, have up to one year from their receipt of the letter to apply for the exemption. The exemption can be granted retroactively for up to 3 years, starting with the assessment date that follows the disability determination date.
