FROM THE TAX COLLECTOR'S OFFICE

Refund Request Forms

Please allow up to 8 weeks from October 31st to process, print and mail your check.

You can look up your account through the tax bill look up link above. If the credit no longer shows, that means we received your form, and it is starting to process. If it still shows the credit then we have not received it or we received it after October 31st, and we would need it signed and dated for a refund check to be sent to you.

If you would like this to be applied to July 2025 taxes simply do not return the form, and it will automatically roll over to July's tax bill.

Delinquent tax bills have been mailed out. See payment options below on how to make your payment.

Delinquent Motor Vehicle bills have been reported to the Department of Motor Vehicle.

Please pay your tax bill as soon as possible to avoid having a registration held up.

It will be necessary to have all accounts paid to be able to register a vehicle. Please make sure you pay your taxes at least **2 weeks** before you need to register your vehicle to make sure you have no compliance issues. You can check DMV's online services under compliance issues to ensure you are clear before you go to DMV. If you need clearance before the 2-week period of time then you will need to make your payment with a credit/debit card online or in the office. Payment can be made with cash or money order in the Tax Collector's Office as well.

Please make us aware you are requesting a release for DMV as it is not immediately taken off.

PLEASE BE ADVISED The Town of Bolton is under contract with TaxServ Capital services for the collection of some of the Towns delinquent taxes. 
