SCRAP METAL - OCTOBER 7-11, 2024

Curbside scrap metal collection will be held the week of October 7-11, 2024. **Items for collection must be curbside by Sunday Night, October 6.** 

**Acceptable:** Noncombustible items such as appliances, chairs, grills (no propane tanks), tent frames, fire pits, bike frames, metal poles, and lawnmowers with no gas or oil, and there is a 100lb weight limit on any of the items.

**Unacceptable:** Motor vehicle parts, machinery, and items weighing more than 100 lbs.

Please remember this collection is for scrap metal only, not for bulk waste.

Please note that all acceptable scrap metal items will be picked up by Friday afternoon. Items not retrieved by then will be considered non-acceptable.
