### NOTICE OF REFERENDUM - TOWN OF BOLTON

Pursuant to Section 8.5(3) of the Bolton Town Charter, electors and others qualified to vote at referendum in the **Town of Bolton** are **hereby warned of a referendum to be held in the aforesaid Town of Bolton at the Parish Center at St. Maurice Church, 32 Hebron Road, Bolton, CT, on Tuesday, June 16, 2026, from 12 PM to 8 PM.** The purpose of this referendum is to vote yes or no on the following question:

“SHALL THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF BOLTON CONNECTICUT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2027 AS RECOMMENDED BY THE FINANCE COMMITTEE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$26,696,962 BE ADOPTED?”

Voting machines will be used. Absentee ballots are available in the Town Clerk’s office.

**Indian Notch Park Season Passes on sale**  
**Wednesday, June 17 @ 9 AM, CASH OR CHECK ONLY!**  
Tickets will be sold in the Recreation Office at 222 Bolton Center Rd,  
Bolton, CT 06043.

- ***Proof of Residency will be required to pay resident rates.*** Up to two license plate numbers of an immediate family are allowed on a pass. Passes may only be purchased if the license plate numbers for both vehicles are known. No additions or changes will be permitted after the pass has been issued. Passes are non-transferable, and there will be no refunds or replacements for lost, damaged or stolen passes. Misuse of a pass will result in it being revoked. Having a pass does not guarantee entry if the park is full, and only one vehicle at a time is permitted to use the pass.

- \$50 - Resident | \$100 - Non-Resident
- \$25 - Senior Resident | \$100 Senior Non-Resident
