- **CT Energy Assistance Program**

- ACCESS Community Action Agency, 1315 Main St. Willimantic – 860-860-450-7487.
- Available September – March for home owners and renters (even heat included).
- Apply in-person, online, by email, or by mail.
- May include shut-off prevention, matching payment program, or reduced electricity rate.

- **Generation Power CT (formerly Operation Fuel)**

- Applications can be submitted online: [www.gpct.org](http://www.gpct.org), or through an Application Support Center: Bolton Senior & Social Services, 104 Notch Road, 860-647-9196.
- Available for four energy cycles: September 2-10, November 2-10, January 2-10, March 2-10.
- Applicants can apply for one energy award in a 12-month period.
- May include assistance with a future delivery of fuel or assistance toward a past due electric balance.
- Applicants are ranked for severity of need so not all applicants will receive benefit but can re-apply.

- **Bolton Resident Assistance Fund**

- Application for consideration of one-time grant through Bolton Senior & Social Services after all other energy assistance opportunities have been exhausted. Call 860-647-9196 to schedule an appointment.
