The Bolton Lake Regional Water Pollution Control Authority (BLRWPCA) held a Public Hearing on November 29, 2017 at the Bolton Town Hall with Chair Robert Morra presiding. Also in attendance were: members Richard Hayes, Daniel Wright, and Daniel Champagne; alternate members Cheryl Udin, Joyce Stille, and Michael Purcaro; Robert Grasis, Vernon WPCA Director; Dr. Christina Ilies; and James Aldrich.

R. Morra Called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00 P.M. and read the legal notice. Purpose of hearing was to hear public comment on the proposed benefit assessment for 1120 Boston Turnpike, Bolton, CT for Bolton Cosmetic and Family Dentistry. J. Aldrich and Dr. Ilies provided information and data on the proposed operation and water usage. For 3 ½ days per week, 7 full time staff will be working. Due to new technology, they believe water usage would be less than the amount of one EDU.
