8) **Proposed HRC Vision** (Proposed from submissions during creation of our Mission Statement):

“A thriving Revere where all community members live free of racism, poverty, violence, and other systems of oppression, and where everyone has equitable access, opportunities, and resources, as well as a sense of belonging.”

Chair Grillo Marra reports that this Vision is language which was discussed and saved from past meetings during the creation of HRC Mission Statement.

Commissioner McGee MOTIONS to accept the HRC Vision and Chief Bright seconds; All in favor.

9) **HRC Yearly Roadmap of Activities** (first draft)

- Chair Grillo Marra states that this Roadmap of Activities will serve as a guideline based on the past 2.5 years since HRC reactivation and it is a fluid document which can be edited over time. However, it will at least give a skeletal structure for the HRC to refer and utilize.
- Chair also states that these are preliminary discussions to create an overview. Details and implementation will follow.
- Chair screen shares the Roadmap of Activities document.
 - NOTE: Any discussion prompting edits to the document will be incorporated and the edited document will be shared at the next HRC monthly meeting.
- Other discussion points:
 - Director Correa to form a new group drawing on Chairs or Designees from HRC, Cultural Council, Arts Commission, Disabilities Commissions, Travel and Tourism, and Mayor’s Office so we can streamline communication and support each other, rather than duplicate efforts. To consider other employees, members, and groups to include.
 - How to be as inclusive as possible with so many Awareness Months/Events and other related topics? Discussed using City demographics as a guide (REMAP could help with demographic data) as well as consider topics or areas that need more visibility and understanding. Also discussed having a central area, i.e., digital announcement screen or other format, to enable the listing of multiple events or announcements.
 - What is diversity? We need to look beyond race and gender.
 - Disability Awareness Month is in March. The HRC will add this to our Cultural and Awareness Events calendar. Director Correa is working with Ralph DeCicco, Chair of Disabilities Commission, to revisit accessibility plans in ALL City buildings, including signage.
 - HRC will also add Teen Dating Violence Awareness (Feb) and Sexual Violence Awareness (April) to the Cultural and Awareness Events calendar.
