- The city of Revere has an overall low incidence of disease, though the COVID-19 figures remained high with 87 confirmed cases in the city in July, it does not take into account the unreported cases.
- o Massachusetts is seeing a spike in COVID and upper-respiratory diseases
- Massachusetts Department of Public Health confirmed that a Worcester-area resident who had returned from overseas travel was confirmed with measles in July, the first such incidence in since 2020
- o individuals who do not know their measles vaccine status should consider getting at least an initial dose of the MMR vaccine.
