Request for Consent to Repetition the Zoning Board of Appeals

To Ms. Simmons-Herling, Chair:

Please accept this letter, with accompanied plans, as a formal request to the Revere Planning Board to allow the applicant to re-petition the Revere Zoning Board of Appeals for variances as required by the City of Revere Site Plan Review.

In support of this request the attached plans shows material changes to address each of the required variances and lessen the proposed impact.

- A. The overall number of units has been reduced from the original 40 down to 28. The reduction in units allows for a decreased deficiency in the parking variance ratio.
- B. The reduction in volume allowed for a repositioning of the overall structure to both benefit abutters at the rear of the building.
- C. The building has also be moved an additional five feet from Green Street which lessens the impact to traffic and reduces the lot coverage
- D. The applicant has added a roof deck increasing the amount of open space available for the project

In addition to these material changes to the proposed structure the applicant has also agreed to a number of infrastructure improvements. Applicant will install a

fire hydrant on Green Street; make improvements to both the water and sewer lines; and provide an agreed amount of trees for use at the direction of the Ward Councillor throughout Ward One

Applicant has also agreed to a condition of allowing three units to be marked as "affordable units".

We ask that this matter be place on the next public meeting of the Revere Planning Board. Please feel free to contact me should any additional information be needed. Thank you


