### Request for Finding of Fact - Special Permit

Now comes the applicant <u>Robert Inello</u> who has applied to this Honorable City Council for a special permit for property located at <u>727 Revere Beach Parkway</u>, <u>Revere</u>, <u>Massachusetts</u> and asks that said Council make the following findings of fact:

- 1. That the proposed use would be in harmony with the general purpose and intent of the Zoning Ordinance for the following reasons:
  - (a) The proposed use of the Property is in harmony with the intent of the Zoning Ordinance as it encourages the most appropriate use of land throughout the City. *See* Revere Zoning Oridinances, § 17.04.010.
- 2. That the specific site is an appropriate location for such use for the following reasons:
  - (a) The proposed project represents a distinct opportunity to develop an underutilized structure into a modern self-storage building. This Property is uniquely situated for the proposed self-storage building given its location on Revere Beach Parkway, a major thoroughfare in the City.
- 3. That the specific site has adequate public sewerage and water facilities and water systems for the following reasons:
  - (a) There are adequate and appropriate facilities already available and accessible, or will otherwise be installed by the Applicant as necessary, to properly service the proposed use.
- 4. That the use as developed will not adversely affect the neighborhood, for the following reasons:
  - (a) This longstanding commercial property will continue with no additional adverse impact on the neighborhood. Self-storage is a very low intensity use that has minimal impact on traffic or demands on parking. Additionally, aside from emergency fire exits that will only be used in emergency situations, there will be no access to the building from Taft Street. Accordingly, the proposed renovation and use is expected to have no impact on the neighborhood. Moreover, the proposed project would result in a new, high-quality building that will encourage further revitalization in the City of Revere.
- 5. That there will not be a nuisance or serious hazard to vehicles or pedestrians using Revere Beach Parkway for the following reasons:
  - (a) The Property's access and twelve (12) parking spaces are more than adequate for the proposed use. Moreover, as stated above, there will be no rear access to the structure, so there will be no impact to the Taft Street neighborhood.

Dear Councilor Keefe,

I am pleased to inform you that the City has received its annual certification of Free Cash from the Department of Revenue. The General Fund Free Cash has been certified at \$6,303,811 and the Water and Sewer Enterprise Fund has been certified at \$3,017,848. As you may know, the certification of free cash is a calculation of available funds to the City as a result of FY2019 operations.

Free cash is a revenue source that results from the calculation, as of July 1, of a community's remaining, unrestricted funds from its operations of the previous fiscal year based on the balance sheet as of June 30. It typically includes actual receipts in excess of revenue estimates and unspent amounts in departmental budget line items for the year just ending, plus unexpended free cash from the previous year.

In accordance with ordinances of the City of Revere, I am requesting transfers from free cash to the following accounts.

- Transfer of \$ 945,572 to the General Fund Stabilization Fund from General Fund Free Cash
- Transfer of \$ 1,260,762 to the Capital Improvement Stabilization Fund from General Fund Free Cash
- Transfer of \$ 250,000 to the Other Post Employment Benefit Trust Fund from General Fund Free Cash
- Transfer of \$ 452,677 to the Water and Sewer Stabilization Fund from Water and Sewer Free Cash

These transfers will bring the City's Stabilization Funds and OPEB Trust Fund Balances to record levels. Specifically, the City will have in excess of \$9.5 million in the General Stabilization Fund, \$7.2 million in the Water and Sewer Stabilization Fund, \$2.3 million in the Capital Improvement Trust Fund, and over \$750,000 in the recently created OPEB Trust Fund.

I will be in attendance at the February 10th City Council meeting to answer any questions on this matter.

As you are aware, the City experienced a tornado back in July of 2014. Many buildings were affected by this tornado, and I am happy to report, most of all repairs have been completed to those buildings that had damages. Insurance proceeds in the amount of \$6.9 million were appropriated in August of 2017 to pay for tornado related damages.

I now respectfully request that we appropriate the remainder of the funds from these insurance proceeds to continue with renovations and improvements necessary to City Hall and other city owned buildings as they relate to the recent ADA report conducted as a result of a \$125,000 grant the City received. Further, improvements such as the renovation of the City Hall Council Chamber, the auditorium, and other areas of many of our municipal building are desperately needed.

As part of the City's Capital Improvement Plan, I respectfully request that in accordance with Massachusetts General Law Chapter 44 Section 53 that the remaining funds available be appropriated for repairs and maintenance needed to comply with the results of the ADA study and to address many of the deferred maintenance needs and other improvements that will modernize space, address long standing safety issues, and preserve our municipal buildings, which are assets of the City and its stakeholders.


