Esteemed Traffic Commission,

I write in support of the proposed Title 10 amendments relative to parking violations. As you may know, the City's vendor, Kelley & Ryan, is transitioning the Parking Department over to new software that will more efficiently and accurately handle ticketing, violation letters, and appeal letters. To ensure a seamless transition into this streamlined enforcement system, the Parking Director reached out to the Solicitor's Office for assistance in cleaning up our current traffic ordinances that will make up the database for the new system. The primary objective of these updates is to provide our vendor and members of the public with definitive, unambiguous ordinance language that can be accurately mapped to their corresponding violation.

Please note: these amendments do not propose any new prohibitions, increased fines, or changes to existing parking restrictions. This is strictly a technical and linguistic refinement of our existing code. Some ordinances were duplicative of others, some violations prohibited the same conduct while referencing different ordinance sections, and other violations were not correctly aligned with their corresponding ordinances.

By updating the structure of these ordinances now, we will significantly reduce the administrative burden of correcting clerical errors after the vendor implements the new system, as well as offer the public more streamlined and understandable rationales for violations.

Thank you for your time and continued support in improving our City's infrastructure.

**A REGULATION FURTHER AMENDING TITLE 10 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF REVERE**

Be it ordained as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 10.32.020 of Title 10 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Revere is hereby amended by deleting this section in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following:

§ 10.32.020 Specific locations and restrictions.

Parking is prohibited, restricted or limited as to time, space, and streets in accordance with a schedule of streets designated as Schedules VIII and XXIV of this title, to which reference is made and which Schedules VIII and XXIV are specifically incorporated in this section. No operator shall park a vehicle in the designated prohibited sections or in the restricted locations for longer than is designated in the respective Schedule, except as otherwise provided in that schedule, or where there is a time limit as to parking. When a snow emergency is declared by the City of Revere, no operator shall park a vehicle in the restricted locations as designated in Schedule XXIV.

SECTION 2. Section 10.32.120(A) of Title 10 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Revere is hereby amended by inserting the following new sub-section:

(1) No person shall allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in their name to stand or park adjacent to curb ramps or other methods permitting sidewalk access to a handicapped person.

SECTION 3. Section 10.32.120(B) of Title 10 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Revere is hereby amended by deleting reference to "Schedule I(C)" and inserting in place thereof reference to "Schedule I(F)."

SECTION 4. Section 10.99.010, Schedule I of Title 10 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Revere is hereby amended by assigning #31 to a current un-numbered violation under Group D, and by amending the name of the same violation:

Current violation: "Parking of any bus, taxicab, hackney, pupil or livery vehicle upon any street other than at a taxi stand."

New violation: #31 "Bus, taxi, pupil, or livery vehicle parked in a prohibited area."

SECTION 5. Section 10.99.010, Schedule I of Title 10 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Revere is hereby amended by assigning #37 to a current un-

numbered violation under Group D which is currently titled "Parking in a bus lane."

SECTION 6. Section 10.99.010, Schedule I of Title 10 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Revere is hereby amended by deleting violation #10 in its entirety.

SECTION 7. Section 10.32.150 of Title 10 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Revere is hereby amended by deleting this section in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following:

§ 10.32.150 Misuse of bus stops and taxicab stands.

It is unlawful for the operator of any vehicle other than a bus operated by a regional transit authority to park in an officially designated bus stand or bus lane, or for the operator of any vehicle other than a taxicab or hackney to stand or park in an officially designated taxicab or hackney stand. Bus stops are listed in Schedule XIV of this title and taxicab stands are listed in Schedule XV of this title.

SECTION 8. Section 10.32.160 of Title 10 of the Revere Revised Ordinances of the City of Revere is hereby amended by amending the title of the section, deleting the first paragraph, and inserting in place thereof the following:

§ 10.32.160 Transportation vehicles parked in prohibited areas.

It is unlawful for the operator of any bus, taxicab, hackney, pupil, or livery vehicle to park upon any street at any time, except at a stand specifically designated for that individual vehicle type, which include: busses at bus stands, and taxicabs or hackneys at taxicab and hackney stands. The owner or lessee of any bus, taxicab, hackney, pupil or livery shall be allowed to park overnight between the hours of eight p.m. and eight a.m. within the municipal parking lot, the north lot or any other parking lot allowed by the parking clerk, provided such owner or lessee secures a parking sticker for such overnight parking. The fee and conditions for such parking sticker shall be determined by the parking clerk. The penalty for violation of the provisions of this section shall be the penalty established for parking a bus, taxicab, hackney, pupil or livery vehicle away from its designated parking stand as provided for by Schedule I of Title 10. The failure to pay the foregoing violation by a person or company licensed by the city pursuant to Sections 5.44.040 and 5.44.060 shall be grounds for the Registry of Motor Vehicles to deny renewal of said license. Vehicles licensed by the Revere Police Department shall be exempt between eight a.m. and five p.m.

SECTION 9. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

To Whom It May Concern:

I, **Luis Becerril**, hereby certify that I am the owner of the property located at 54 Carlson Avenue, Revere, MA 02151. I further confirm that **Mrs. Jean Serino** is a tenant that currently resides at 54 Carlson Avenue, Revere, MA, 02151.

Mrs. Serino – who has a handicapped placard issued by the MA Registry of Motor Vehicles due to mobility issues – parks her vehicle in front of the property on the city-owned street and not in the property’s driveway because the parking space in front of the home is closer to the entrance to her unit. If she were to park in the driveway, she would have to walk down a slant and around the property to enter her unit. It is safer and more direct for Mrs. Serino to park on the city-owned street. Parking in the driveway would be more of a hardship for her, and therefore, I prefer that she should be parked in the parking spot directly in front of the property – not in the driveway.

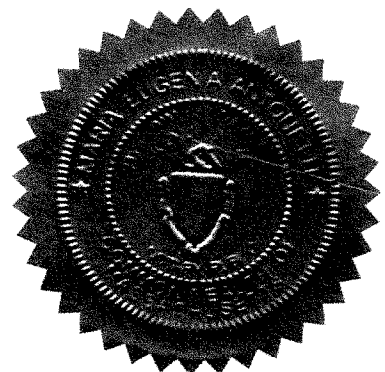
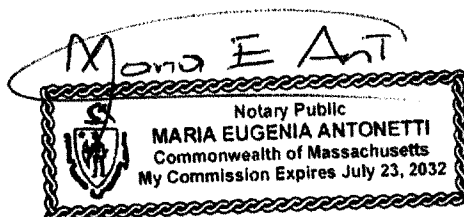
For these reasons, I respectfully ask that the Traffic Commission grant this handicapped parking spot. If you require additional information, please feel free to contact me.

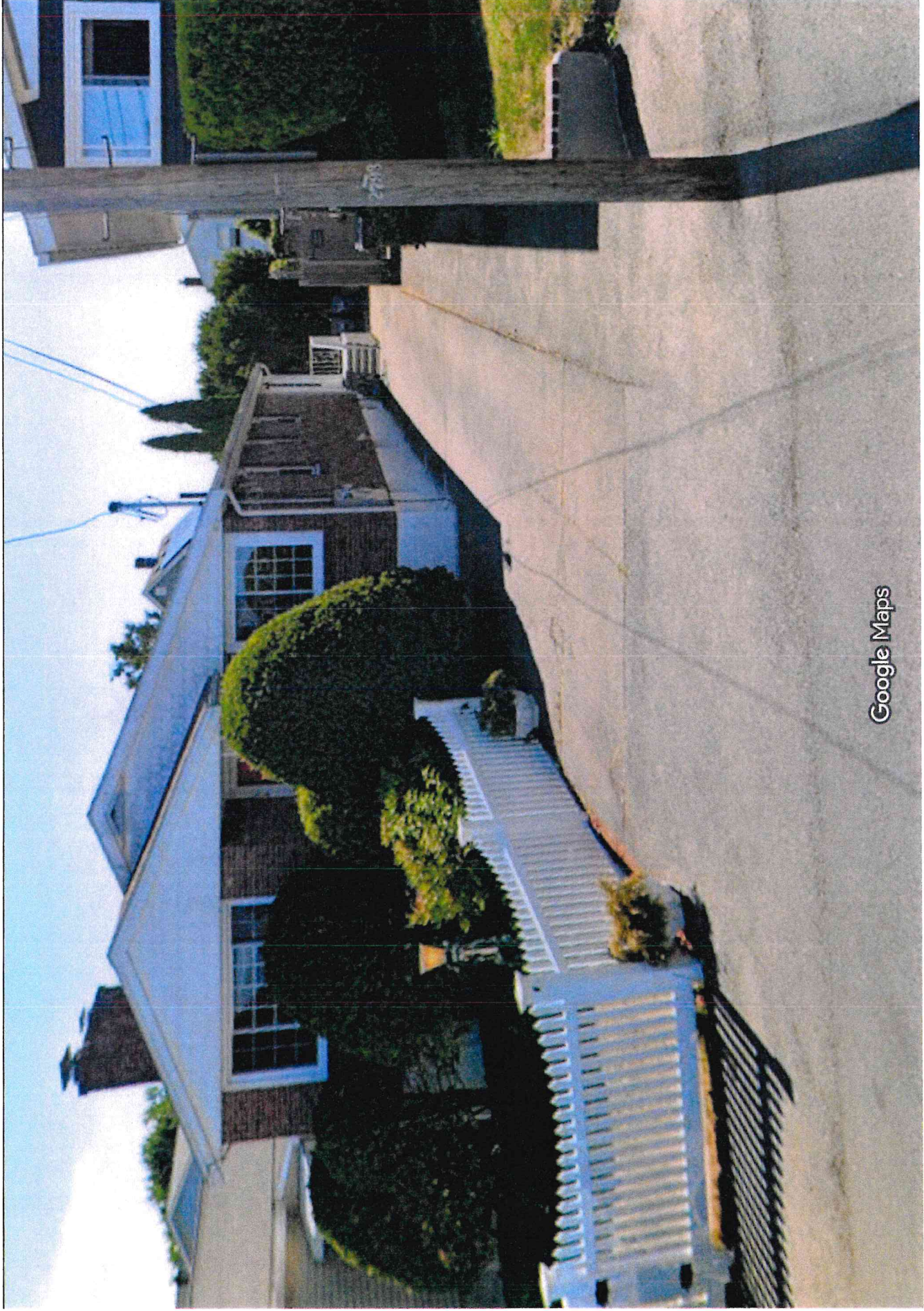
