Councillor Silvestri is submitting the following amendments to the proposed ordinance for consideration by the Legislative Affairs Sub-Committee:

Amendment #1 Proposed Section 8.40.040 Enforcement is hereby by striking the second sentence of the paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:

Any person or entity found to be in violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a penalty of \$300 per violation per day, as set forth in Chapter 1.12 Art. II and Chapter 1.16 of Revere Revised Ordinances.

§ 8.40.040 Enforcement.

The provisions of this chapter shall be enforced by the Revere Police Department, the Department of Municipal Inspections, or any other authorized agent of the City. ~~Any person or entity found to be in violation of this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Chapter 1.12, Art. II and Chapter 1.16 of Revere Revised Ordinances.~~ Any person or entity found to be in violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a penalty of \$300 per violation per day, as set forth in Chapter 1.12 Art. II and Chapter 1.16 of Revere Revised Ordinances.

Amendment #2 Section 2. is hereby amended by striking “thirtieth” and inserting in place thereof “sixtieth”.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect on the ~~thirtieth~~ sixtieth day after its enactment.
