### **FOREWORD**

This section is a statement from the Superintendent regarding the essential of this year's budget.

### **LEADERSHIP**

This section delineates the members of the School Committee and Administrative Team who worked together on leading this year's budget process.

This is the section that displays visually (through means of a color coded pie chart) the proportional breakout of all funding sources as the School Department's disposal in the coming fiscal year.

This section delineates all grant and revolving funds supplementing our appropriated budget.

### **SALARIES COVER AND DETAIL**

This is the section that presents summary information on all salary accounts. It is ordered by series and breaks things down in easy-to-quickly-peruse departmental subtotals. Following is a section that presents every single individual employee who is in the budget for the upcoming fiscal year regardless of funding source. It is organized by series in accord with Department of Education accounting mandates. Base salary, longevity, differentials, and any other compensatory realities are clearly presented for each person.

Following is a section that presents individual appropriated non-salary general ledger accounts for the upcoming fiscal year. It is organized by series in accord with Department of Education accounting mandates. Additional detail is provided where possible relative to description of expense.

## A WORD FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT

As you know, the budgeting process for the Revere Public Schools has been extremely complicated in each of the last 5 years. This has resulted from the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education changing the definition of poverty from Low Income (one qualifies for free/reduced lunch) to Economically Disadvantaged (one receives SNAP, TAFDC, foster care, or certain Medicaid benefits). We were initially optimistic that this trend would be reversed for FY21 with the passage of the Student Opportunity Act. Earlier this year, we met with teachers, families, and community members to identify new district goals that would support our mission and vision toward increased equity for all students, inclusive practices, increasing staff diversity, Social and Emotional Learning, and amplifying student voice in all aspects of educational programming. We allocated our anticipated increased funding toward these initiatives. And then COVID19 hit.

Our budgeting process has continued under the guidance of our CFO, Matt Kruse, and School Committee Ways and Means Chair, Mr. Ferrante. All planned new positions have been placed on hold. An early retirement incentive was offered to some year-round staff members with the intent of not replacing them until it becomes necessary to do so. In light of anticipated changes to next school year, we are hoping to save salary expenditures through these means. We have curtailed non-salary spending in order to reserve as much funding as possible for next school year. Our goal with this budget is to preserve all employee positions. It represents level services from last year with contractual salary increments and cuts to non-salary accounts. We have expended more reserve funds than we normally do in order to balance this budget. With the information we have gathered through multiple meetings at the state level, we feel the attached budget is a ***most-likely*** scenario for anticipated Chapter 70 funds. We acknowledge that actual funding could be higher in which case we will move toward implementation of the plan stakeholders helped us develop in February. We also acknowledge that the actual funding could be lower. That would diminish our plans to maintain all staff positions but we will not make any staff changes until such a reality presents itself.

Absent from this budget is accounting for COVID19 related expenses like PPE, technology devices, and cleaning services that will likely be needed. Our funding through the CARES act (approximately \$2M) will be used exclusively for those items with a primary focus on the PPE and cleaning. We are also working on supplemental grants to assist with these costs and are leveraging state purchasing programs to minimize our costs.

Although our budget position remains grim and ambiguous, we know our amazing staff will continue to push forward toward helping all students grow and achieve academically. We are incredibly thankful for all of their hard work, dedication, and resilience in these very difficult times for all public school employees.

When possible, we continue to direct funding toward achieving our district goals:

- Increasing equity for all students
- Fostering inclusive practices
- Increasing staff diversity
- Focusing on Social and Emotional Learning
- Amplifying student voice

Should there be a drastic change due to legislative updates to the Chapter 70 formula, we will make decisions based on the feedback we have received for members of the RPS community and with the best interests of our students in mind.


