Notice is hereby given in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 185 of the Acts of 1983, and Chapter 13 of the Acts of 1984, that the City of Revere Traffic Commission will conduct a Public Hearing on August 15, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. in the City Councillor Joseph A. Del Grosso Council Chambers of Revere City Hall relative to the following proposed amendments to the parking and traffic regulations of the City of Revere:

Public Hearing:

1. The Mayor request that the Traffic Commission approve the installation of a speed bump on Walnut Avenue in the interest of public safety for the Senior Residents of 50 Walnut Avenue.

2. Amend Schedule II of Title 10, Section C – Left turns Prohibited by adding:

<i>Location:</i>	<i>Direction:</i>	<i>To:</i>	<i>Duration:</i>
<i>North Shore Rd</i>	<i>Southbound</i>	<i>Cove Street</i>	<i>During School Hours/ Residents Excluded</i>

3. Amend Schedule XI of Title 10 Handicapped Person Parking by adding:

288 Crescent Avenue #1

Requests:

1. Amend Schedule IX of Title 10 - RESIDENT PARKING STREETS—TWENTY-FOUR HOUR ENFORCEMENT

Councillor McKenna would like to have the remaining upper half of Endicott Avenue to have 24 hour/7 days a week permit parking. The lower half of Endicott has already been completed.

2. Councillor Guarino-Sawaya requests the installation of a sign stating “Do Not Block Intersection” at Revere Street and Stowers Street.

3. Councillor Guarino-Sawaya requests to move the “No Parking” signs located on Gilbert Avenue from the even side numbered of the street to the odd numbered side of the street.

4. Councillor Cogliandro would like to have 2 crosswalks placed at the intersection of Cushman Avenue and Adams Street. Crosswalks would be placed on Cushman Avenue on both sides of Adams Street. This would allow for pedestrian safety while school is in session.

5. Councillor Cogliandro would request the installation of crosswalks and speed bumps be placed on East Mountain Avenue at the intersection of East Mountain Avenue and Carey Avenue.
6. Councillor Cogliandro would like to request a “Do Not Enter” Sign during the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. placed on Tapley Avenue at the intersection of Broadway
7. Councillor Cogliandro requests the installation of a “No Trucks” sign at Tapley Avenue at the intersection of Broadway.
8. Add a “Do Not Enter” sign onto Linehurst Street from RT1 by Kappy’s Liquors. There was a sign but someone removed it.
9. Amend Schedule V of Title 10- One-way streets by adding the following:

Amend Schedule VI of Title 10 – Heavy Commercial Vehicles – Restricted Streets by adding the following:

Agatha St	Both	Entire Length	
Morris St	Both	Entire Length	
Robins Rd	Both	Entire Length

Waiting on Decision:

Amend Title 10, Section 10.32.210 and 10.32.211 to allow parking of vehicles with pupil plates not to exceed 6 passengers in all areas EXCEPT areas that are currently 24/7 Resident Parking – 1 per household.

The Mayor would like the Traffic Commission to consider a “No Left Turn” from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on North Shore Road to Cove Street during school hours (unless you are a resident of Cove Street). Traffic congestion is out of control and dangerous. Vehicles are making illegal U-turns, blocking the intersection and beeping at students trying to cross. Standish Road would take the traffic flow much better than Cove.
