

# ***Traffic Commission Agenda***

## ***August 22, 2019***

### ***Public Hearings:***

*Notice is hereby given in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 185 of the Acts of 1983, and Chapter 13 of the Acts of 1984, that the City of Revere Traffic Commission will conduct a Public Hearing on August 22, 2019 at 4:00 p.m. in the City Councilor Joseph A. Del Grosso Council Chambers of Revere City Hall relative to the following proposed amendments to the parking and traffic regulations of the City of Revere:*

1. Mr. Robert Button will be addressing the Traffic Commission in regards to Overlook Ridge improvements.
2. Amend Schedule IX of Title 10 Resident Parking Sticker Areas by adding Centennial Ave. from Campbell Ave to Arlington Ave 24/7.
3. The Endicott Ave 60 trial period will be reviewed to determine if it will remain a one way or be reverted back to a two way.
4. Amend **Schedule VI of Title 10 - HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLES—RESTRICTED STREETS** by adding:

4. Councilor Novoselsky requests the following public hearings:
  - a. Permit Parking on Arlington Ave. from Centennial Avenue both sides up to the dead end of the street. Once again I bring to your attention the need for Residential Permit Parking in this area due to commuters parking there and going to use the MBTA to go into Boston taking up spaces for the local residents. I request that Permit parking be 24-hours Monday through Saturday.
  - b. Permit Parking on James Street from Arlington Ave. both sides up to Walnut Avenue. Once again I bring to your attention the need for Residential Permit Parking in this area due to commuters parking there and going to use the MBTA to go into Boston taking up spaces for the local residents. I request that Permit parking be 24-hours Monday through Saturday.
  - c. Permit Parking on Walnut Avenue from Franklin Avenue both sides up to the dead end of the street. Once again I bring to your attention the need for Residential Permit Parking in this area due to commuters parking there and going to use the MBTA to go into Boston taking up spaces for the local residents and the overflow from Hillside Avenue. I request that Permit parking be 24-hours Monday through Saturday.
  - d. New Stop sign on Garfield Avenue northbound at Dix Street. This area is a school zone and traffic has been speeding at this location. The area was recently designed for new crosswalks and street paving through a Safe Routes to School grant.
  - e. New Stop sign on Everett Street southbound at Beach Street leading into Mahoney Circle. Vehicles coming out of Everett Street are flying into the Circle without regard of oncoming traffic. We must try to control this location as much as possible.
  
5. Mr. Ralph Decicco from the Commission on Disabilities requests the following:
  - a. That an emergency handicap person sign be installed at 58 Pearl Ave.
  - b. Remove 512 Park Ave from Schedule XI of Title 10
  - c. Request for a public hearing to install a handicap person sign at 25 Norman St.
