

# ***Traffic Commission September 23, 2021 Public Hearings***

*Notice is hereby given in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 185 of the Acts of 1983, and Chapter 13 of the Acts of 1984, that the City of Revere Traffic Commission will conduct a Public Hearing on September 23, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. in the City Councillor Joseph A. DelGrosso City Council Chambers of Revere City Hall relative to the following proposed amendments to the parking and traffic regulations of the City of Revere:*

1. Various amendments to the following streets located on Riverside: Archer, Lawson, Wadleigh, Gilbert, Frank, Beckert, Tobin, John, River, Thayer, and Hayes Avenues.

Section 1. Schedule VIII of Title 10 Parking Restrictions Generally is hereby amended by removing the no parking on both sides restriction for all streets on the Riverside, excluding Mills Avenue, and provide for parking on one side of those streets. The side of the streets to be designated as “no parking” will be determined by the Traffic Commission.

Section 2. Schedule IX of Title 10 – Resident Parking Streets – Twenty-Four Hour Enforcement is hereby amended by adding all streets on the Riverside, excluding Mills Avenue. The side of the streets to be designated as “24/7 Resident Parking” will be determined by the Traffic Commission.

2. The residents of 420 Revere Beach Blvd wish to continue the Public Hearing from the last Traffic Commission Meeting. The residents are seeking to be resolve issues with regards to permits, visitor passes and caregiver passes.
