**Item #5: CODA (Commissions on Disabilities Alliance) – Meeting Wednesday, December 4, 2024**

- **DPC will be hiring for a few positions, such as a Community Organizer, Executive Assistant, Deaf and Hard of Hearing Ombudsman. For more information and to apply, visit their website at <https://www.dpcma.org/>**
- **DPC also mentioned that the next Legislative session begins again in January. Soon after, they will start having advocacy updates for the new session.**
- **Newburyport COD spoke about a new program they will be implementing called Project Lifesaver. They will partner with their local Police Department and Council on Aging. This technology has a success rate of being able to locate a lost individual within 30 minutes, much faster than others. Their initial cost to implement this will be approximately \$9800 for the first year. This includes wrist or ankle transponders for 14 individuals, along with equipment for three police cars and other equipment needed to be installed throughout the community.
