## Traffic Commission Agenda December 21, 2023

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 185 of the Acts of 1983, and Chapter 13 of the Acts of 1984, that the City of Revere Traffic Commission will conduct a Public Hearing on December 21, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. in the City Councillor Joseph A. Del Grosso Council Chambers of Revere City Hall relative to the following proposed amendments to the parking and traffic regulations of the City of Revere:

## Public Hearing:

1. Discuss Chapter 10.38 – Electric Vehicle Infrastructure and Parking regarding:

The installation of electric vehicle supply equipment upon the city's public ways; to provide a policy in which the City can install electric vehicle charging stations; and assess fees for electric vehicle charging stations.

- 2. Amend Schedule IV of Title 10 Isolated Stop Signs by adding a stop sign on Emmet Terrace at the intersection of School Street.
- 3. Amend Schedule XI of Title 10 Handicapped Person Parking by adding two handicapped signs at the following locations:

29 Trevalley Road 540 Revere Street 76 Orvis Road

4. To amend Schedule VIII of Title 10 by adding Zolla Circle in becoming Residential Parking for 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

## Requests:

1. Continued discussion regarding traffic improvements for the Suffolk Downs development in Revere. The following pedestrian and traffic safety improvements will be discussed and voted on:

The length of Harris Street between Winthrop Avenue and Beach Avenue will be converted from two-way to one-way Northbound, and a single block of Sewall Street from Harris Street to Bixby Street will be converted from two-way to one-way Westbound. These changes are proposed to improve

signalized intersection operations and reduce neighborhood traffic (Amend Schedule V of Title 10, One Way Streets). The Suffolk Downs development proponent will be installing traffic control signage, deriving from the improvements, at the Harris/Sewall, Harris/Butler, Harris/Beach, and Harris/Eustis intersections and provide the City of Revere an allowance, to be used at the City's discretion, for potential future traffic improvements in the area.

- 2. Removal of the Handicapped Sign located at 1465 North Shore Rd. A new resident has purchased the property.
- 3. Approved on July 31, 2023, Council Order 23-181 submitted by Councilor Morabito: That Mayor Patrick Keefe requests the Traffic Commission to establish Hancock Street as a one way heading towards Mountain Avenue.
- 4. Approved on October 30, 2023, Council Order 23-245 submitted by Councillor Novoselsky: That Mayor Patrick Keefe requests the Traffic Commission to hold a public hearing for the purpose of amending Schedule IV of Title 10 to add a Stop Sign on Shirley Avenue Eastbound at Thornton Street.
