**Motions**

**13-248        Motion presented by Councillor Patch: That the Mayor request the Department of Public Works and the City Engineer to fix the drainage problem at the end of Sherman Street. Further, please rectify this situation due to the fact that the water does not drain and floods at the end of 71 Sherman Street.**

**13-249        Motion presented by Councillor Powers: That the Mayor request the Superintendent of Public Works and the City Engineer to investigate what appears to be a sinking service line running down the center of Atwood Street.**

**13-250        Motion presented by Councillor Powers: That the Mayor in the interest of public safety request MA Highway to install a guardrail in the area of 182 North Shore Road. There have been several accidents in that area. Further, that the Mayor direct the Superintendent to replace the fire hydrant that was damaged due to one of these accidents.**

**13-251** Motion presented by Councillor Powers: That the Mayor direct the Suffolk County Maintenance Crew to clean the easterly side of Bay Road it is littered with papers and debris.

**13-252** Motion presented by Councillor Patch: Pursuant to Section 12.12.120, the Council hereby requests that the City of Revere Retirement Board to provide the City Council with a detailed analysis of the full cost of a petition to provide survivor benefits to Kathryn Walsh, the surviving spouse of John P. Walsh, late retired fire captain of the fire department of the City of Revere. Said alternative retirement allowance shall be calculated by the said retirement board, based upon the survivor allowance, as provided for by the first sentence of Chapter 32, Section 12 (ii), Option (c) of the General Laws, had Captain Walsh been allowed to select Option (c) on the date of his retirement from the fire department of the City of Revere and had he nominated his surviving spouse as his Option (c) beneficiary. The Council requests that the Retirement Board return a cost analysis and vote within the 30 day time period allotted by the statute.

**13-253** Motion presented by Councillor Zambuto: That the Mayor request the DCR to install “No U-Turn” signage at 350 Revere Beach Boulevard (St. George Condominium) in the interest of public safety.

**13-254** Motion presented by Councillor Giannino: That the Mayor request the Superintendent of Public Works to notify the contractors responsible for the poor workmanship on sinkholes located at: Ferragamo Way, Washington Ave 100 block, Sargent St. by the exit of the Whelan School, Washington Ave. at Mountain Ave., 270 Fenno St., Page St. at Olive St., and Mountain Ave at Essex St. All of these need to be addressed as we cannot allow contractors to be held unaccountable for not compacting these areas properly. Some of these have been brought up several times and are only getting worse.
