PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEETINGS

All regular and special meetings of the School Committee shall be open to the public. Executive sessions will be held only as prescribed by the Statutes of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

The School Committee desires citizens of the District to attend its meetings so that they may become better acquainted with the operations and the programs of our local public schools. In addition, the Committee would like the opportunity to hear the wishes and ideas of the public.

In order that all citizens who wish to be heard before the Committee have a chance and to ensure the ability of the Committee to conduct the District's business in an orderly manner, the following rules and procedures are adopted:

1. At the start of each regularly scheduled School Committee meeting, individuals or group representatives will be invited to address the Committee. The Chairperson shall determine the length of the public participation segment.
2. Speakers will be allowed three (3) minutes to present their material. The presiding Chairperson may permit extension of this time limit.
3. Topics for discussion must be limited to those items listed on the School Committee meeting agenda for that evening.
4. Improper conduct and remarks will not be allowed. Defamatory or abusive remarks are always out of order. If a speaker persists in improper conduct or remarks, the Chairperson may terminate that individual's privilege of address.
5. All remarks will be addressed through the Chairperson of the meeting.
6. Speakers may offer such objective criticisms of the school operations and programs as concern them, but in public session the Committee will not hear personal complaints of school personnel nor against any member of the school community. Under most circumstances, administrative channels are the proper means for disposition of legitimate complaints involving staff members.
7. Written comments longer than three (3) minutes may be presented to the Committee before or after the meeting for the Committee members' review and consideration at an appropriate time.

TWO PARTNERS, SHARED FOCUS

Throughout nine years of partnership and during this pandemic our goals remained aligned:

PROVIDE A QUALITY MEAL SERVICE PROGRAM TO OUR STUDENTS DESIGNED FOR OUR STUDENTS.

The financial impact of Covid19 to the FY20 School Meals Program was reported last spring. The proactive steps taken to control the financial outcome for FY21 are working. This report will provide an overview of our current program, it's achievements and actions being taken to prepare for our students return.

TWO PARTNERS SHARED FOCUS

WHAT WE'VE DONE

SPRING - 2020

Adapted the program to meet the priorities and ever-changing needs at the start of the pandemic. Immediate systems were put in place to ensure staff safety while providing essential services to our families.

SUMMER - 2020

Worked closely with managers to develop SFSP distribution sites. Managed and expanded purchasing options which resulted in positive financial performance. Prepared locations for various service models, ensuring safety for our students return.

FALL - 2020

Full-time staff returned
Opened food distribution sites at all elementary locations.
Explored and expanded community outreach opportunities.

WHAT WE'RE DOING

PARTICIPATION

To increase meal participation, we adapted our operations to efficiently serve the needs of our students and their families during COVID-19. Students currently receive a week's supply of breakfast and lunch meals. Fresh fruits and vegetables are included as well as $\frac{1}{2}$ gallons of milk. Meal distribution occurs 2x weekly on Tuesdays and Fridays at all elementary school locations.

COLLABORATION

By collaborating with the RPS Transportation Dept. and Revere311, we have developed a meal delivery program for families unable to visit food distribution sites due to quarantine. This program is currently servicing 28 families and providing meals for 58 students.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Our outreach efforts were expanded by working closely with our district and community partners. As a result, we have been able to communicate the features, promotions and availability of our meal program to additional members of our school community.

OUTREACH PROGRAMS

A variety of meals prepared at Revere High School are delivered weekly to families residing in temporary housing. Students participating in the For Kids Only After School Program are receiving these breakfast and lunch meals as well.





COMMUNICATING CRITICAL MEAL UPDATES


