Item #7: Residents' concerns/issues

- **Chair DeCicco discussed the process of having an HP sign removed that is no longer needed. The property owner (New) or (current) would need to send an email to disabilities@revere.org. This letter would need to include a copy of the property purchase and sale agreement or a legal document showing they are the homeowner, with their name on it, for the location of the HP sign, which is no longer needed and should be removed. The reason for this is that no one can inaccurately report the removal of an HP, and the city also has a written request on file. (More details regarding this were explained during the meeting and can be viewed at the Revere YouTube channel link mentioned above)**
