

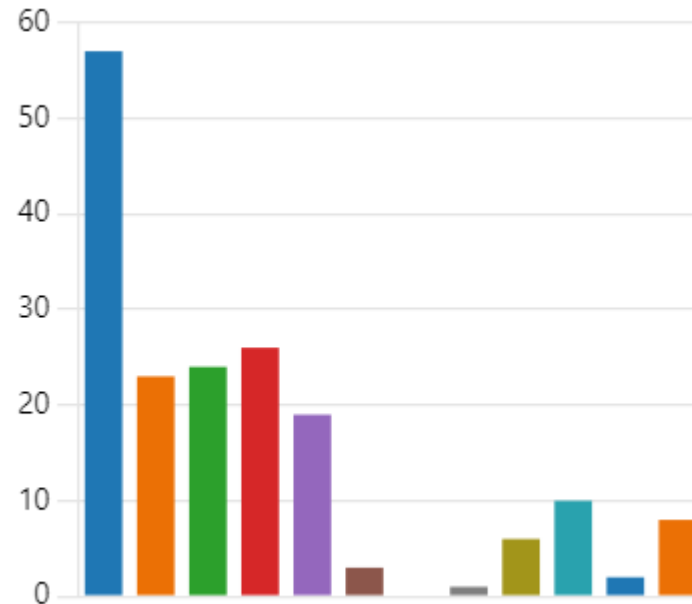

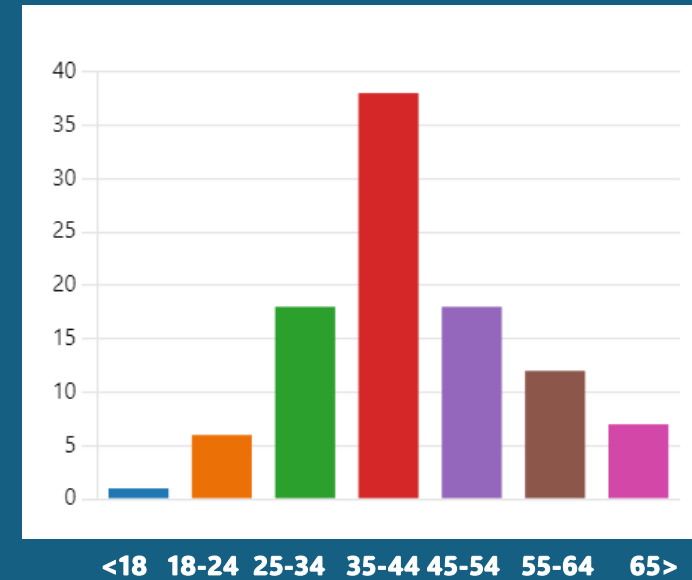

Access to Narcan – 55%

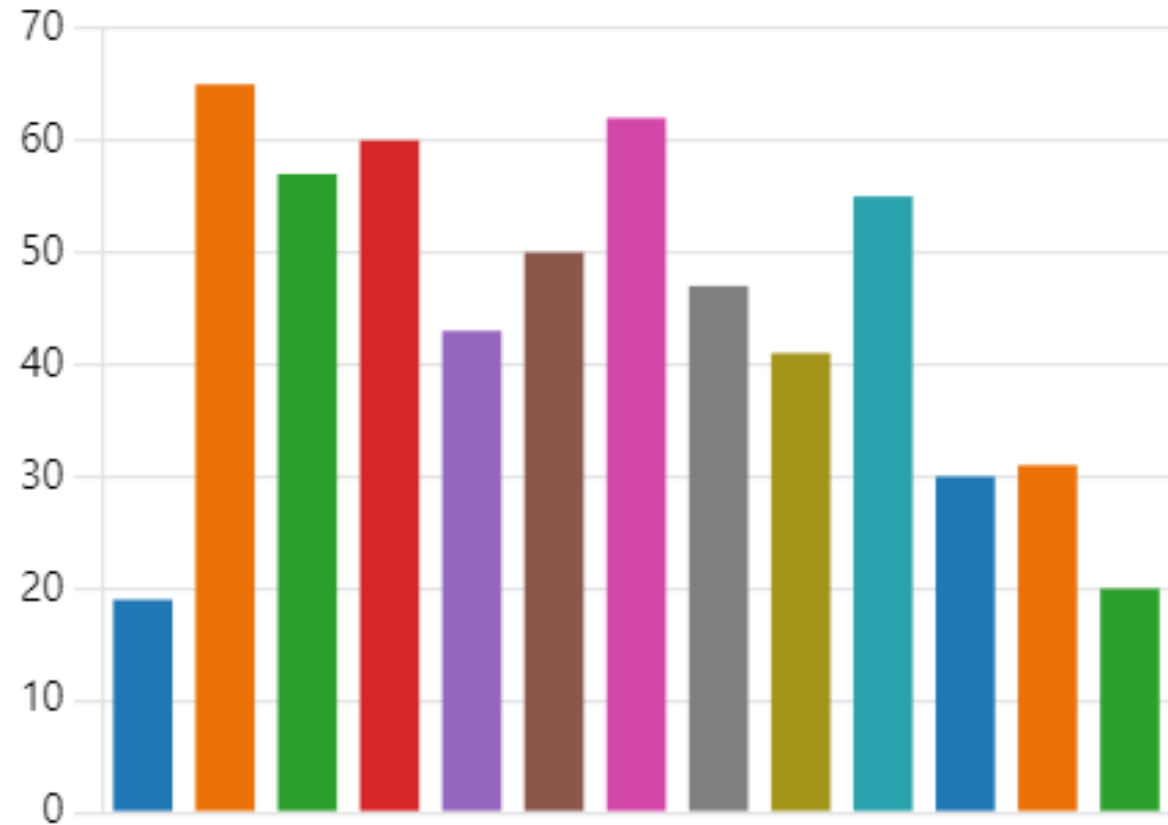

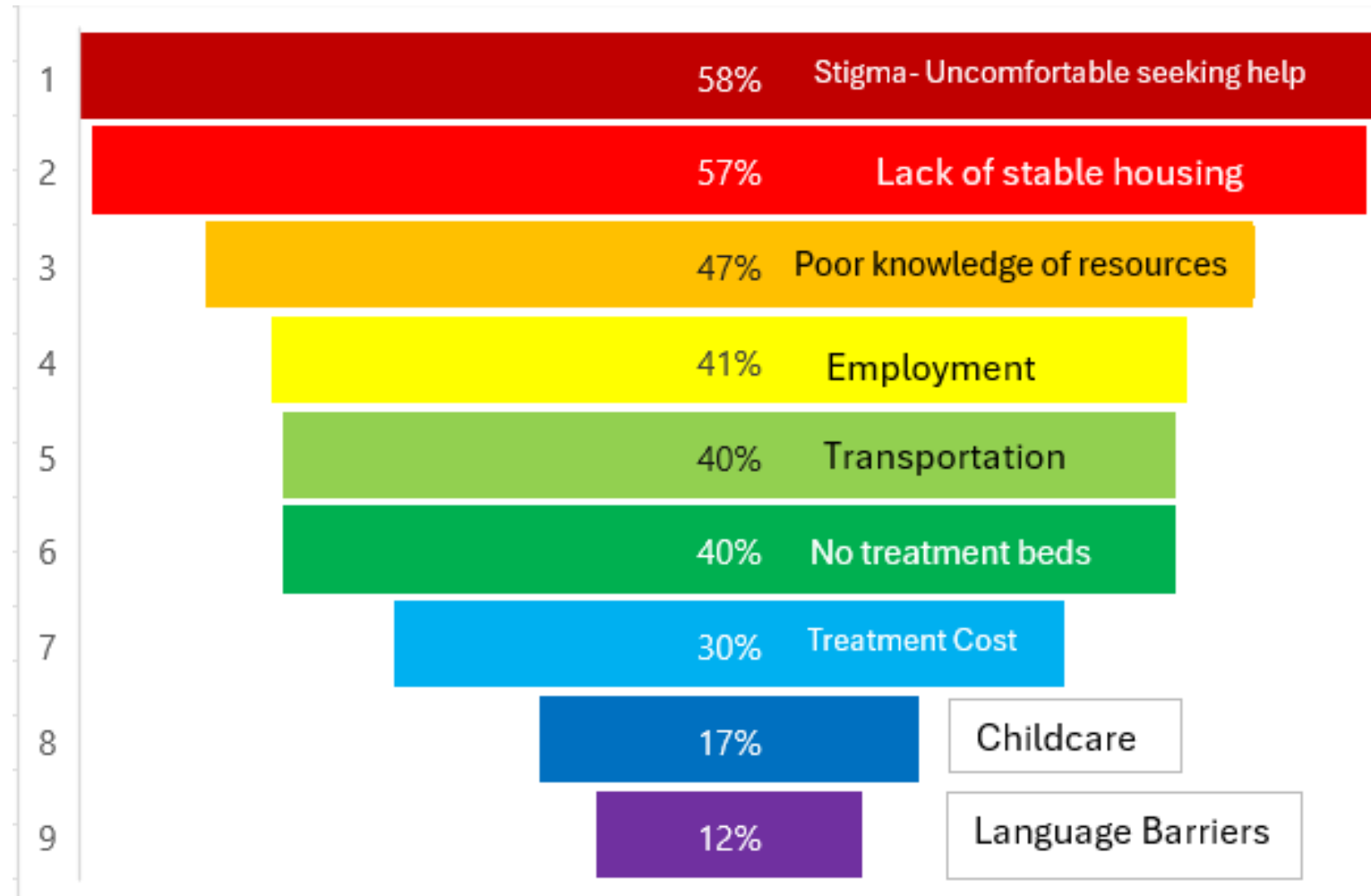

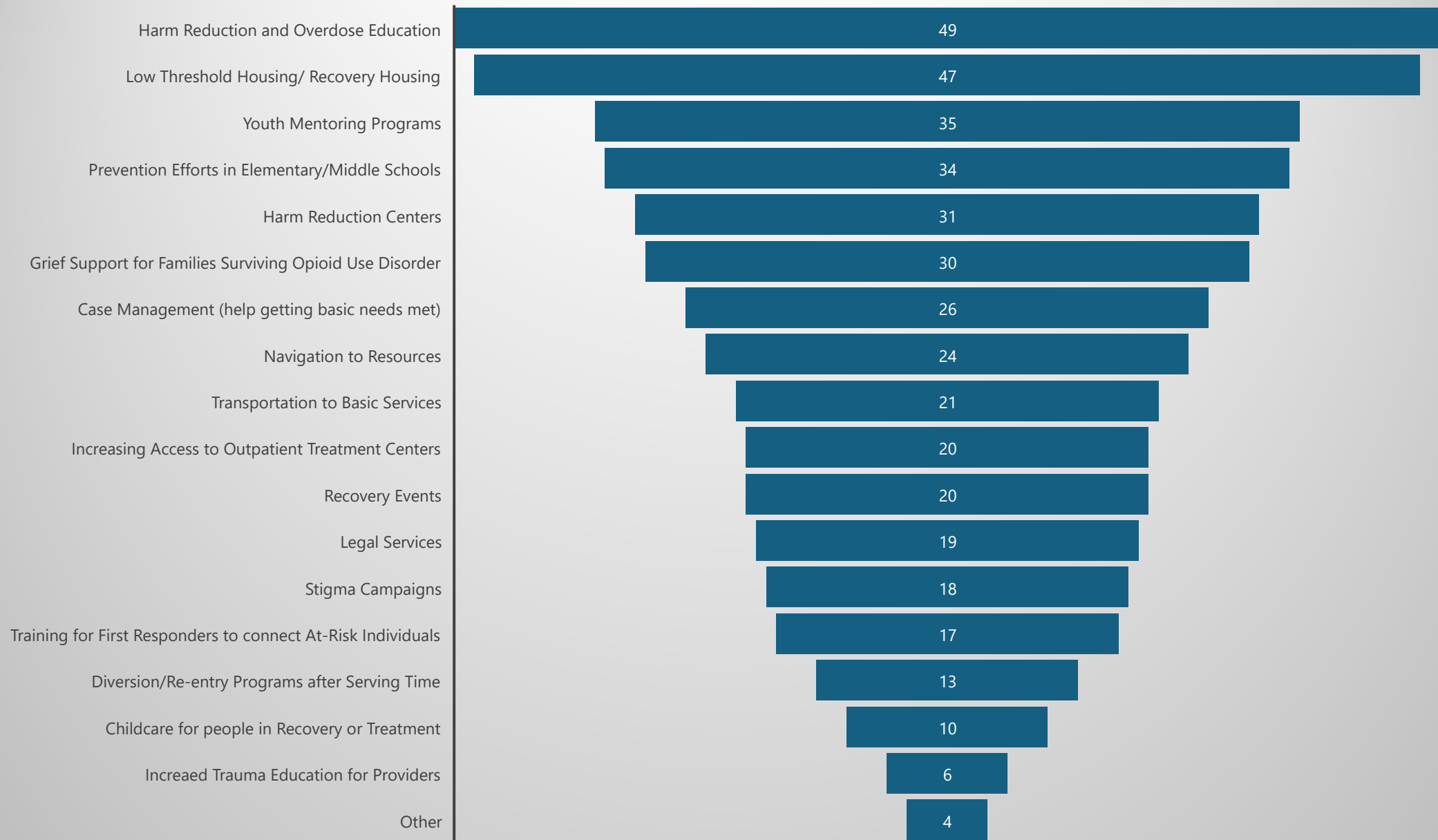
