COLA Increase

The Increased COLA (Cost of Living Adjustment) for Fiscal Year 2025 went into effect on July $1^{\rm st}$. The Board voted for a base of 3% increase on an increased base of \$14,000, which equates to a maximum of \$35 per month or \$420 per year.
