## **WEP & GPO Repealed**

On January 5, 2025, the Social Security Fairness Act went into law, effectively repealing the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP) and Government Pension Offset (GPO), which have negatively impacted Revere public employees and their beneficiaries for decades.

The WEP was a formula used to decrease the Social Security benefits for individuals who receive "non-covered pensions" (ie, Revere Retirement Benefit payments) and qualify for Social Security benefits based on Social Security-covered earnings. The GPO adjusts spousal Social Security or widow(er) benefits for individuals who receive "non-covered pensions."

#### **Revere Retirement System Valuation Results**

The Revere Retirement System's latest valuation report, conducted every two years, assessed the System's funding ratio as 70% funded. This is a major step towards our goal of 100% fully funded.

## **Changes to Veterans' Buyback**

On August 8, 2024, Governor Healey signed into law Chapter 178 of the Acts of 2024, the HERO Act, "An Act Honoring, Empowering, and Recognizing our Service members and Veterans." The new law removes the 180-day statutory deadline for purchasing military service. Instead, it institutes a purchasing deadline of within a year of vesting in the retirement system, effectively 11 years of service, to either pay in full or enter into an installment plan. It also creates a one-time, one-year grace period (August 8, 2025) for anyone who has not purchased their military service, giving members vested at the time of the new law an opportunity to do so.

If you are a Veteran and have already completed your military service purchase, you do not need to take any action. If you have completed more than 11 years of creditable service and have yet to purchase or enter into an installment agreement, you have until August 8, 2025 to do so.

#### **PERAC 91A Process**

Revere disability retirees are required by law to submit a statement of their earnings. PERAC mails disability retirees an Annual Statement of Earned Income every year which they must complete and submit to PERAC on or before the tax filing deadline.
