Adoption of State Park Season Pass Policy (Dina Walker) BACKGROUND: At the April 22, 2025 Selectboard meeting, the SB partially adopted the George & Raymond Frank Foundation (Camp Kawanhee) Free State Park Passes Policy ("Policy") as a Town policy. Since then, Dina Walker has contacted the Foundation who has no objections to the draft policy as written. The Chair recommends that the portion of the draft policy re lottery for state park passes be open to all taxpayers.
