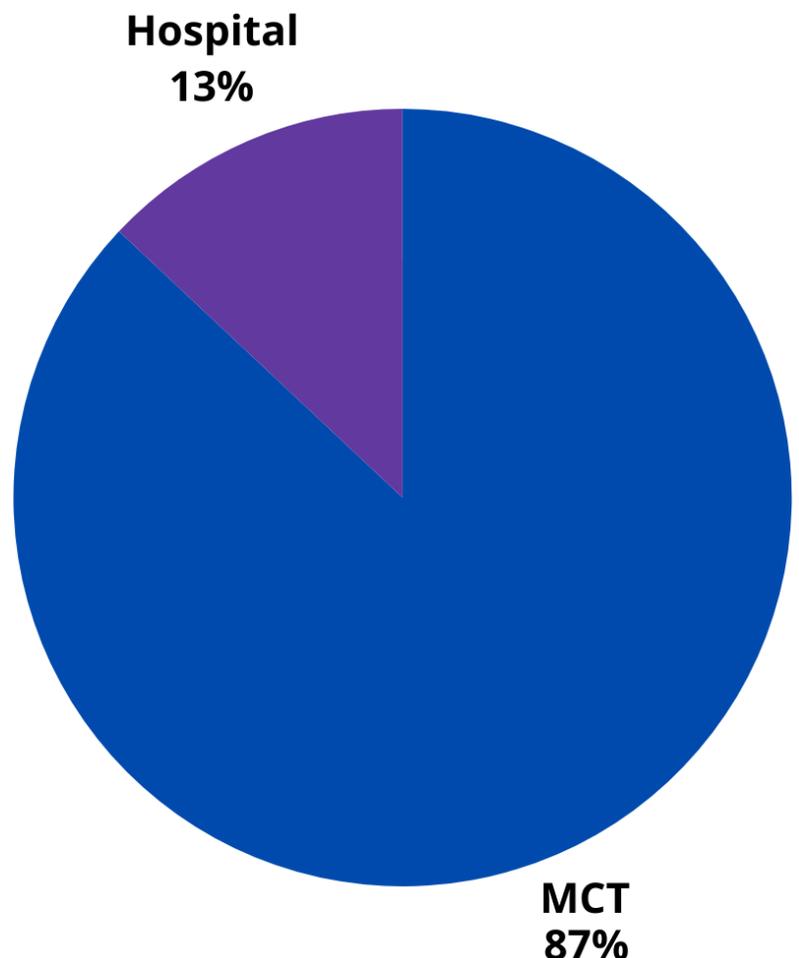

Level 4	69	MCT without law enforcement on standby.
Level 5	5	MCT clinician responds to a secure facility with or without Peer Support Specialist
Level 6	62	MCT phone/telehealth responses
