- **Unhoused Status: 9**
- **Transportation: 14**
- **Detox/Respite: 1**
- **Secondary Beneficiaries: 67**

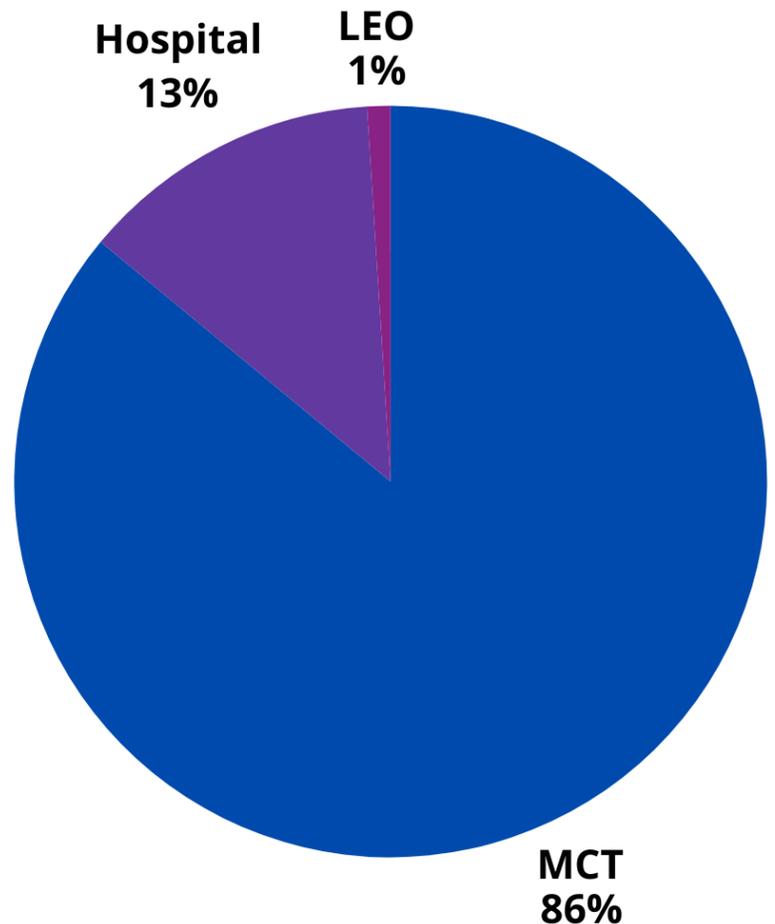

## FECC Data for Calls by Response Level:

<b>Level 1:</b>	5	Law Enforcement response required with MCT accompanying or staging.
<b>Level 2</b>	4	MCT Lead with law enforcement staging near the scene.
<b>Level 3</b>	42	Law enforcement will not respond until requested by MCT.
<b>Level 4</b>	56	MCT without law enforcement on standby.
<b>Level 5</b>	2	MCT clinician responds to a secure facility with or without Peer Support Specialist
