

RESOLUTION NO. 5230

**A RESOLUTION TO REOPEN LACEY STREET BETWEEN FIRST
AVENUE AND SECOND AVENUE BY SEPTEMBER 30, 2026**

WHEREAS, Lacey Street, between First and Second Avenue, was temporarily closed this summer to accommodate proposed renovation of the Ice Museum and also to help the Starter Block project; and

WHEREAS, the street was turned into a skateboard park and barricaded off; and

WHEREAS, with the advent of winter coming it is desirable to reopen Lacey Street to through traffic and make it available for emergency vehicles by providing direct access when needed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS, ALASKA, as follows:

Section 1. That Lacey Street be reopened by September 30, 2026, and the traditional traffic pattern be restored on this public street.

Section 2. That this resolution is effective six days after adoption.
