The COF maintains Aurora Drive and will continue to maintain Aurora Drive after project completion.

The affected roadway for this work includes Aurora Drive from Hanson Road to College Road, including the Aurora Drive Noyes Slough Bridge #0209.

Continue routine seasonal maintenance of the Aurora Drive Noyes Slough Bridge #0209 including pedestrian facilities, signage, and drainage constructed under this project.

Federal Highway Administration funds are involved in this project. The COF will manage this facility in conformance with all Federal Highway Administration requirements including all applicable management responsibilities of rights of way within the extent of this project as depicted in Exhibit A attached to this agreement.

The COF will be responsible for permitting all utilities within the COF managed rights of way for Aurora Drive, in accordance with 23 C.F.R. §645.209(g).
