**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO APPLY
FOR FUNDS FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES (DOT & PF) FOR
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS**

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks has been notified by the Alaska DOT&PF of a new funding opportunity for EMS organizations to fund essential equipment and training to support EMS providers in keeping Alaska's roadways safe; and

WHEREAS, the Fairbanks Fire Department will use funds to purchase equipment for an EMS bike response team to patrol summer events and increase mobility amongst large crowds (\$45,500) and for an off road all terrain emergency vehicle (\$90,000); and

WHEREAS, the grant will provide up to \$150,000 for the chosen agency and no match is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents required for requesting funds on behalf of the City for this grant.
