**A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO DESIGN ALASKA, INC
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$316,686 TO DESIGN THE CITY HALL HEATING

WHEREAS, in accordance with Fairbanks General Code (FGC) Chapter 54, Article V, Competitive Sealed Proposals, proposals were solicited for professional consulting services for the City Hall Heating Upgrade Project (RFP 24-03); and

WHEREAS, the most responsive proposer for professional consulting services to design the City Hall Heating Upgrade Project is Design Alaska, Inc in the amount of three hundred sixteen thousand, six hundred eighty-six dollars and zero cents (\$316,686.00); and

WHEREAS, funding for the project will be provided from the Capital Fund.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Fairbanks, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract and such other documents in a form approved by the City Attorney as may be necessary to effect award of this contract to Design Alaska, Inc to design the City Hall Heating Upgrade Project.


