**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO
PARTICIPATE IN THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
CONSERVATION'S ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA)
COMMUNITY-WIDE ASSESSMENT GRANT APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation has been notified by the EPA of a \$2,000,000 Brownfields Assessment grant that states are eligible to apply for; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska would like to include Fairbanks as a target area within its application; and


WHEREAS, the State of Alaska will apply for up to \$2,000,000 and will allocate funds to each project location after award notice; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks will participate in the application by providing information about the Minnie Street Corridor area and Barnette Street projects, as needed for the grant application (see attached Exhibits A and B); and

WHEREAS, if the project is chosen for an award, the City of Fairbanks will have no requirement to provide matching funds or manage the award, and any benefits received will be in-kind.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents required for participating in the State's application for the EPA's Community-Wide Assessment grant.



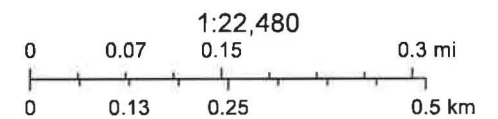
