**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO APPLY  
FOR FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF  
HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE FFY2024 ASSISTANCE TO  
FIREFIGHTERS GRANT (AFG)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairbanks has been notified by the United States Department of Homeland Security that the City of Fairbanks is eligible to apply for the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Program to enhance operations and safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairbanks plans to use the funds for the purchase of a heavy rescue unit (\$2,000,000); and


**WHEREAS**, the AFG designates heavy rescue units as a high priority item to be funded under this program; and

**WHEREAS**, a 10% match is required to be provided by the Capital Fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents required for requesting funds on behalf of the City for the Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the effective date of this resolution is six days after adoption.


