A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO APPLY FOR FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE FY2025 REBUILDING AMERICAN INFRASTRUCTURE WITH SUSTAINABILITY AND EQUITY (RAISE) DISCRETIONARY GRANT PROGRAM FOR ISLAND HOMES SUBDIVISION RECONSTRUCTION

WHEREAS, the Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) Discretionary Grant program provides the United States Department of Transportation a unique opportunity to invest in road, rail, transit, and port projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks plans to apply for funds to reconstruct roads, sidewalks, and improve drainage in the Island Homes subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks plans to request \$18,950,000, and a match is not required but will be provided in the amount of \$2,050,000. Contingency funds are required in the amount of \$2,100,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks will provide contingency funds in the amount of \$1,300,000, and Golden Heart Utilities intends to provide contingency funds in the amount of \$800,000, pending board approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents required for requesting funds on behalf of the City for the FY2025 Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity Discretionary Grant for Island Homes Subdivision reconstruction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is effective six days after adoption.
