A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS TO APPLY FOR FUNDS FROM THE ALASKA DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE FFY2025 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks has been notified by the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management that the City is eligible to apply for State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) funds to address planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise needs to prepare in the event of an act of terrorism or other catastrophic events; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks plans to use the funds to purchase mobile vehicle barriers and a trailer for Fairbanks Fire Department (\$118,000), radios for the Fairbanks Police Department (\$263,000), and radios for the Fairbanks Emergency Communications Center (\$55,000); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks plans to request \$436,000, and no match is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents required for requesting funds on behalf of the City for the FFY2025 State Homeland Security Program grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the effective date of this resolution is six days after adoption.
