**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE

FACILITIES FOR 8TH AVENUE, DOYON ESTATES, AND TESORO AVENUE**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) will be performing maintenance and preservation activities on 8th Avenue, Doyon Estates, and Tesoro Avenue, Project #NFHWY00913; and

**WHEREAS**, the project will include gravel or asphalt maintenance and preservation activities on roads, sidewalks, and pathways; and


**WHEREAS**, under the proposed maintenance agreement between the City and DOT&PF (Attachment A), the City would be responsible for the management and maintenance of 8th Avenue, Doyon Estates, and Tesoro Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is currently responsible for the maintenance of 8th Avenue, Doyon Estates, and Tesoro Avenue, and that responsibility will continue under the agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Fairbanks City Council authorizes the Mayor to execute the attached maintenance agreement with the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities for 8th Avenue, Doyon Estates, and Tesoro Avenue.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the effective date of this resolution is six days after adoption.

## Memorandum of Agreement for the

## Maintenance & Management of the

## FAST Area Surface Upgrades FFY2025 #NFHWY00913

## Between

**The State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF)**

**and**

**The City of Fairbanks (COF)**

**1. PURPOSE:**

- The purpose of this agreement is to provide for the management and maintenance of 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Doyon Estates, and Tesoro Avenue that will be constructed under the FAST Area Surface Upgrades FFY2025 project.

**2. THE DOT&PF AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING:**

- Coordinate all funding for design and construction through the Fairbanks Area Surface Transportation (FAST) Planning Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

**3. THE COF AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING:**

- The COF maintains 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Doyon Estates, and Tesoro Avenue and after completion of this project, the COF will continue to maintain this facility. Provide routine maintenance that includes but is not limited to pavement and surface repairs, signage, vegetation control, storm drainage, etc.
- Improvements to the above facility fall within the scope of work for the FAST Improvement Program which may include the following: perform gravel or asphalt surface maintenance and preservation activities on roads, sidewalks and pathways. Work may also include new or upgraded illumination, signing and striping, storm drains and intersection improvements including non-motorized crossings, as well as ADA upgrades to sidewalks and curb ramps.
- Federal Highway Administration funds are involved in this project. In accordance with 23 C.F.R. §645.209(g), the COF will manage this facility in conformance with all Federal Highway Administration requirements including all applicable management responsibilities of rights of way and utilities.

**4. IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED THAT:**

- The above parties will coordinate and participate in the review of the final design plans prior to construction.
- The above parties will coordinate and participate in the final inspection of the construction project.

**5. TERM**

- This MOA shall become effective on the date of the last signature and shall apply in perpetuity.

*"Keep Alaska Moving through service and infrastructure."*

6. TERMINATION

- This agreement may be terminated by mutual consent of both parties.
- The DOT&PF reserve the rights to terminate this agreement if the COF fails to comply with any provisions herein.

7. EFFECTIVE DATES & SIGNATURES:

- This agreement shall become effective upon execution by both parties.
