Certain lots or parcels of land, with any buildings thereon, situated in the Town of Weld, County of Franklin, and State of Maine, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8" iron rebar set at a fifteen inch (15") white pine tree marking the southernmost corner of land now or formerly of Ralph Flood and Carol Flood, said iron pin being near the intersection of the right of way serving Floods' property; thence North 47° 56' 26" East along line of land of said Floods eighty-nine and thirty-four hundredths (89.34) feet to an iron rebar; thence North 73° 12' 24" East continuing along line of land of said Floods four hundred thirty-three and fifty-five hundredths (433.55) feet to an iron rebar set in a stone wall: thence South 06° 16' 57" East along said stone wall one hundred twenty-four and fiftyfour hundredths (124.54) feet to an iron rebar set on the northerly side of a right of way; thence South 06° 30' 21" East crossing said right of way forty-four and ninety-four hundredths (44.94) feet to an iron rebar at the end of a stone wall; thence South 06° 07' 54" East along said stone wall two hundred seventy-six and ten hundreds (276.10) feet to an iron rebar: thence South 76° 04' 54" West three hundred sixty-five and eighty hundredths (365.80) feet to an iron rebar set eleven (11) feet easterly of the thread of a stream; thence continuing South 76° 04' 54" West eleven (11) feet to the thread of said stream; thence in a northwesterly direction along the thread of said stream to the point where said stream intersects the westerly side of a right of way; thence North 31° 48' 38" East continuing along the general westerly side of said right of way eighty-four and seventy-one hundredths (84.71) feet to an iron rebar set at the base of a fifteen inch (15") white pine tree and the point of beginning.

Also hereby conveying an easement and right of way for all purposes for which roads and ways are used in the State of Maine, including the installation and maintenance of utilities either above or below ground, and travel by foot or vehicle, the location of said right of way being described as follows:

Beginning on the northerly sideline of Center Hill Road where the same is on a course of South 69° 01' 44" West and meets the southerly boundary of the roadway labeled "right of way" on said survey (said "right of way" being the subject of "Note 4" on

said survey); thence northerly, the easement and right of way being the same width as the same "right of way" as depicted on said survey, for the entire length of said "right of way" to the location where said "right of way" meets the southerly line of land depicted on said survey as "N/F Ronald McCann, Willard Tower," as well as the southerly line of a parcel labeled "To Be Conveyed to Riggs, Et Als.", and also the southerly line of a well-established road depicted on said survey by one solid line and one broken line which are shown respectively as lying adjacent to two parcels, the solid line being adjacent to parcel labeled "N/F Ronald McCann, Willard Tower", and the broken line being adjacent to parcel labeled "To Be Conveyed to Riggs, Et Als."; thence northerly, the easement and right of way being of the same width as the said well-established road as depicted on said survey, for the entire length of said well-established road to the current location of the southerly line of the driveway of Ralph Flood and Carol Flood, being near a 5/8" rebar set at 15" white pine tree.
